

#### **'Pope's Astronomer' Visits Adrian for Talk and Open Reception**

Brother Guy Consolmagno, SJ, the Director of the Vatican Observatory, visits Adrian in March to offer a program titled A Jesuit's Guide to the Stars and for an evening reception and short presentation.

A Jesuit's Guide to the Stars is from 1:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Thursday, March 13, 2025, at Weber Retreat and Conference Center. The cost for the program, which is in person and livestreamed, is \$35. Registration is required. The reception -7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on the same day at Weber Center - is free and open to the public. The evening will include soft drinks, hors d'oeuvres, and a half-hour presentation.

In this program, Brother Guy describes how we find God in the joy we experience in observing the sky. A native of Detroit, he earned degrees in Planetary Science from MIT and the University of Arizona and was a research fellow at Harvard and MIT. He entered the Jesuits in 1989 and has served at the Vatican Observatory since 1993. Pope Francis appointed him Director of the Vatican Observatory in 2015.
